PADI Assistant Instructor Course

Program Overview

The PADI Assistant Instructor (AI) Course is the first part of the PADI Instructor Development Course (IDC). This is designed to provide options: you may want to set your own professional development pace; or you may want to get a feel for the "Instructor life" without fully assuming the responsibilities of being an instructor; or you even may want to expand your personal confidence in SCUBA knowledge and skillset.

Prerequisites

- Minimum six months as a Certified Open Water Diver
- PADI Divemaster Certification (or equivalent)
- Be at least 18 years old
- Copies of all non-PADI/EFR certification cards
- Open Water Diver, Advanced Open Water Diver, Rescue Diver
- CPR and First Aid certification within the previous 24 months of IE date
- Submit a Diver Medical attesting to dive fitness signed by an authorized medical professional within the previous 12 months AND have had no medical condition changes.
- At least 60 logged dives, including experience in deep, night and navigation, to start the Al Course

Registering

To reserve your spot in our AI Course, you will make a non-refundable payment to cover materials and administrative fees at least four weeks before the start of the Course; the balance will be due on or before the first in-person session.

You will complete the **Assistant Instructor Course Learning Agreement**. This will be signed when you make your deposit to reserve your spot in our Al Course. To enable your Al Course paperwork to be prepared, you will also complete the **Al Candidate Information Sheet**.

The PADI fees will be paid directly to PADI upon successful completion of the Course.
