

Emergency First Response Instructor Course

Program Overview

The Emergency First Response Instructor Course provides you with the additional training necessary to teach the four Courses – Primary Care (CPR), Secondary Care (First Aid), CPR & AED, and Care for Children. This Course builds on your skills as a CPR & First Aid provider and focuses on developing your instructional abilities to teach protocols that are compliant with internationally recognized emergency care guidelines. Through independent study, classroom sessions and practice teaching assignments, you learn to conduct the EFR Courses. These Courses can be taught to anyone with an interest. An EFR Instructor rating is required to become a PADI Instructor.

Prerequisites

- Be at least 18 years old
- Have completed an EFR Primary and Secondary Care Course (or qualifying training) within the past 24 months.
